Session Scripture

Key Points

- Life's relationships are live and are made to be improvised, not petrified.

- Don't let appearances fool you... I am becoming my best from the inside out.
- I relate to others by pulling up rich resources from deep within me and giving them freely, while enjoying what they are able to give in return.
 But my true restoration comes only from what I pull down, in my true communion with God.
- I am a rare gift of time, beauty, energy; and material resources; but unlike the world's market place, my value increases each time I make a gift of my giving.
